WHY REFUGEE EDUCATION? --- UN Sustainable Development Goal 4 Turkey

- 2.7 million Syrians under temporary protection in Turkey
- ≈3.5 million registered and unregistered refugees in Turkey

Istanbul Aydın University

- 4059 International students
- 417 Syrian students
- The main campus of Istanbul Aydın University is at Küçükçekmece District
 - One of the most refugee-populated district in Istanbul
 - 38.278 Syrian refugees / 540.000 Syrian refugees in Istanbul

ASPIRE Refugee Project at Columbia University, School of Social Work

Traumas of service givers to Syrian refugees

RESCUE Project

- Co-funded under Erasmus+ Capacity Building in Higher Education
- Coordinated by UNIMED, 6 partners from Europe, 8 partners from Southern Mediterranean Countries (Jordan, Lebanon, Iraq)
- Creating ad hoc units (Refugee Student Operational Support Unit)

Turkish Language Training Projects

- Turkish Language Training for 600 Syrian youth under temporary protection between ages 15-18
- Turkish language training for 100 young Syrians in Hatay and Osmaniye
- Turkish language training to 50 Syrian housewives

Vocational Trainings

- Hairdressing training courses for 40 Syrian refugees
- Graphic design training for 25 Syrian refugees

Blended Vocational Certificate Program

- Cooperation with KIRON Open Higher Education
- Blended certificate program with online-offline modules in Business Administration to improve vocational skills of Syrian refugees

Syrian Teachers' In-service Training Project by IAU Faculty of Education

- to contribute Syrian teachers' professional development and help them to adapt to Turkish educational system
- 82 percent of all Syrian teachers working in Istanbul
- 52 hours theoretical and practical lessons from 7 modules to develop their pedagogical and content knowledge.

IAU Peer Mentoring Program

- Peer mentoring for supporting students academic and social development
- Study Groups
- English speaking club

Challenges

- Legal status of refugees
 - Turkey: temporary protection status
- Prejudices/perceptions of local people + teachers, students, students' families
 - Sharing resources --- employability, amount of house rents, medical care, etc...
 - Cultural differences
- Language barrier
- Lack of academic and career counseling
 - Study what??? For what???
 - 86% of the world's refugees ---- in developing regions where the governments are already struggling to educate their own people
