





2021-2022 Teaching and Learning Principles

Istanbul Aydın University Senate, in order to minimize the effects of the Covid- 19 global epidemic, to prevent the spread of the virus, and not to endanger the health of our students, academic and administrative staff, has taken the following decisions to conduct teaching and learning in the form of 35% of the courses online and 65% of the courses on campus for the 2021- 2022 academic year, fall term.

The Senate of the university has just released this information and the situation might change according to the evolution of the pandemic.













2021-2022 Teaching and Learning Principles

Florya Halit Aydın Campus, will be open to the use of our students, provided that epidemic measures (physical distance, masks, hygiene and other measures) are meticulously followed during the 2021-2022 academic year, but the maximum number of students will be planned.

Namely students will be requested to:

- Provide information on vaccination
- If they are not vaccined they need to undertake a PCR test every 72 hours. Testing is paid for by the student. The test fee is 250 TL.
- In order to enter the campus students must also obtain a HES code. 3. This code is needed prior to arrival in Turkey and can be obtained at: https://register.health.gov.tr/

How the exams will be conducted (supervised online, face-to-face, etc.) will be decided later according to the progress of the pandemic.

ANNOUNCEMENT

As of 30 December 2020, all international passengers arriving Turkey via air travel will have to present a negative PCR test result conducted within the last 72 hours.

This procedure will be effective until 1 March 2021 and it is in effect for all transfer, transit, and passengers of 6 years of age and older. Passengers who do not submit a negative PCR test result will not admitted to the flight.















- Starting September 6, intercity travel by plane, bus, train, or other public transportation will require proof of vaccination or a negative PCR test taken 48 hours prior to travel. This requirement applies to individuals 18 years old and older. Travel using a private vehicle will not require proof of vaccination or a negative PCR test.
- Starting September 6, entry into establishments such as concerts, cinemas, theaters, and crowded events will require proof of vaccination, or a negative PCR test taken 48 hours prior to the event. This requirement applies to individuals 18 years old and older.
- Individuals who have not received their vaccination through the Government of Turkey, and thus will not be able to confirm their vaccination status through the e-nabiz/HES system, may show a printed copy of their vaccination certificate along with identification.
- Passengers who traveled to Turkey from Afghanistan and Pakistan or who have been in these countries in the last 14 days must undergo quarantine for 10 days. Passengers will be given a PCR test on the 7th day of quarantine and, if the test result is negative, they will be released from quarantine. If the PCR test result is still positive, measures will be taken in accordance with the Ministry of Health COVID-19 guidelines.













5. When entering Turkey from countries not specifically mentioned in the previous slides, passengers will not be required to submit a negative PCR test result if they submit a document issued by the relevant country's official authorities stating that they have been vaccinated with a WHO approved vaccine at least 14 days before entrance to Turkey and/or have had the disease and cured within the last 6 months. Quarantine measures will not be applied for these passengers. If passengers departing from these countries cannot submit a vaccine certificate or the documents proving that they have had the disease according to the stated rules, submission of a negative PCR test result taken within 72 hours before entering Turkey or negative rapid antigen test result taken within 48 hours before entering Turkey will be deemed sufficient.

- -We strongly recommend that you do not to go to crowded areas unless it's absolutely necessary upon your arrival in Turkey.
- -You will not be able to enter the campus unless your are vaccinated/ provide a negative PCR taken max. 72 hours before the visit. The processes you need to follow immediately after your arrival to Istanbul will all be managed online.
- -When you will be able to enter the Campus you will be asked to provide the HES code at the entrance together with the information on vaccination/negative PCR test.

Stay safe and healthy during **COVID** -19

What is HES code

The HES Code is a personal code implemented by the Ministry of Health in order to reduce the presence of passengers at the airport who are positive or have contact with a positive patient and to prevent them from participating in domestic flights. Even if you travel by train, bus, plane or private vehicle, you need to get a HES code.

There are 2 options for obtaining the HES code:

- is needed prior to arrival in Turkey and can be obtained at: This code https://register.health.gov.tr/. You will be asked about it upon flying to Turkey. Depending from the country from where you are flying you might be asked about the negative PCR and/or the proof of vaccination.
- 2. In Turkey, to use the HES code app and generate additional HES code, **you must have** a Turkish mobile number.













What you should know about HES

- •HES code is mandatory for all citizens travelling to the Republic of Turkey.
- •HES codes will be checked 24 hours before the flight and passengers will be notified regarding their status. Passengers who are not approved by the Ministry of Health for travel will not be permitted for flying.
- •Each HES code is valid only for a certain period or without time limit. The HES code expiry date must be at least 7 days after the last flight date on your ticket. Otherwise, your reservation will not be confirmed.













HOW TO GET A HES CODE?

VIA "HAYAT EVE SIĞAR" APPLICATION



Go to "HES Kodu İşlemleri" section through the Hayat Eve Siğar mobile application

Click the "HES Kodu Oluştur" button. Choose the code usage period (Kod kullanım süresi) then create the code.

Write "HES" then leave a space. Write respectively your Identity Number, last 4 digits of your identity card's serial number, sharing time (number of days). Finally, send an SMS to 2023.

THE CODE WILL BE VALID FOR 15 DAYS

Residence Permit(İkamet)

All international students in Turkey, regardless of status, must apply for a Residence Permit (İkamet tezkeresi) at the Directorate for Migration Management within one month of entering in Turkey.

Necessary documents:

- Online applicant form at https://e-ikamet.goc.gov.tr/
- 4 biometric photos
- Passport scan
- Scan of student visa (if any)
- Letter of confirmation from IAU Student Affairs Office (T block)
- Health insurance valid for residence permit application (20.09.2021-05.02.2022)
- After providing all the neccesary papers, IAU International Student and Staff Affairs(ISSA) will deliver your documents to the Directorate of Migration Management Office and you will receive your residence permit cards after some time.
- All applications will be processed together with the Erasmus+ Office. Only incoming students who are not Turkish and who follow IAU courses from Turkey need to apply for IKAMET.

IAU STUDENT CARD.

With this card you can use the student entrance and UBIS System via our Kiosks

IT Department (D Block) issues these cards ! IF you lose this card at any time during your Mobility visit the Erasmus+ Office ASAP.

I.E.T.T. TRANSPORTATION CARD

With this transportation card, you can travel anywhere you want in Istanbul. You can obtain the card from the yellow vending machines located in all public transport stations in Istanbul. The fee for the card is 6 TL.

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
