

2020-2021 Teaching and Learning Principles

Istanbul Aydın University Senate, in order to minimize the effects of the Covid-19 global pandemic, to prevent the spread of the virus, and not to endanger the health of our students, academic and administrative staff, has taken the following decisions to conduct teaching and learning in the form of blended (hybrid) education in the Fall Semester of the 2020-2021 academic year.

The Senate of the university has still to decide on how the spring term courses will be delivered.















2020-2021 Teaching and Learning Principles

- 1. The common compulsory courses will be on online.
- 2. Fully theoretical courses, which do not require laboratory or workshop practice, will start only online. The execution method can be re-evaluated according to progress of the pandemic.
- 3. Full theoretical courses which need the numerical problemsolving and using of a whiteboard or visual material will be conducted both online and face-to-face in reduced class capacity.













2020-2021 Teaching and Learning Principles

- 4. Courses in the form of workshop or laboratory practice will be realized face-to- face by taking necessary measures and in reduced class capacity.
- 5. Florya Halit Aydın Campus, will be open to the use of our students, provided that epidemic measures (physical distance, masks, hygiene and other measures) are meticulously followed during the 2020-2021 academic year, but the maximum number of students will be planned.
- 6. How the exams will be conducted (supervised online, face-to-face, etc.) will be decided later according to the progress of the pandemic.

ANNOUNCEMENT

As of 30 December 2020, all international passengers arriving Turkey via air travel will have to present a negative PCR test result conducted within the last 72 hours.

This procedure will be effective until
1 March 2021 and it is in effect for all transfer, transit, and passengers of 6 years of age and older. Passengers who do not submit a negative PCR test result will not admitted to the flight.















General Safety Measures

- -We strongly recommend that you to stay indoors as much as possible for the first 14 days after your arrival in Istanbul and not to go to crowded areas unless it's absolutely necessary.
- -You will not be able to enter the campus within the first 14 days after entering Turkey because of safety reasons. The processes you need to follow immediately after your arrival to Istanbul will all be managed online.
- -When you will be able to enter the Campus you will be asked to provide the HES code at the entrance.

Stay safe and healthy during COVID -19

What is HES code

The HES Code is a personal code implemented by the Ministry of Health in order to reduce the presence of passengers at the airport who are positive or have contact with a positive patient and to prevent them from participating in domestic flights. Even if you travel by train, bus, plane or private vehicle, you need to get a HES code.

You must have a Turkish mobile number to obtain a HES code.

What you should know about HES

- •HES code is mandatory on all domestic flights for citizens of the Republic of Turkey and people whose Foreigner's ID No issued by the Turkish Republic start with 97, 98, and 99. The HES code is not mandatory for foreign passengers.
- •HES codes will be checked 24 hours before the flight and passengers will be notified regarding their status. Passengers who are not approved by the Ministry of Health for travel will not be permitted for flying.
- •Each HES code is valid only for a certain period or without time limit. The HES code expiry date must be at least 7 days after the last flight date on your ticket. Otherwise, your reservation will not be confirmed.
- •The HES code is not mandatory for domestic flights with connecting international flights at the moment (Trabzon-London flight via Istanbul). Where there is more than 24 hours of time between connecting flights, HES code is mandatory before the domestic flights.













HOW TO GET A HES CODE?

Go to "HES Kodu İşlemleri" section through the Hayat Eve Siğar mobile application

Click the "HES Kodu Oluştur" button. Choose the code usage period (Kod kullanım süresi) then create the code.

Write "HES" then leave a space. Write respectively your Identity Number, last 4 digits of your identity card's serial number, sharing time (number of days). Finally, send an SMS to 2023.

THE CODE WILL BE VALID FOR 15 DAYS

REGISTER AS IAU ERASMUS STUDENT APPLY FOR RESIDENCE PERMIT















Residence Permit(İkamet)

All international students in Turkey, regardless of status, must apply for a Residence Permit (İkamet tezkeresi) at the Directorate for Migration Management within one month of entering in Turkey.

Necessary documents:

- Online applicant form at https://e-ikamet.goc.gov.tr/
- 4 biometric photos
- Passport scan
- Scan of student visa (if any)
- Letter of confirmation from IAU Student Affairs Office (Erasmus+ Office will provide you it)
- Health insurance valid for residence permit application (17.02.2021-26.06.2021)
- After providing all the neccesary papers, IAU International Student and Staff Affairs(ISSA) will deliver your documents to the Directorate of Migration Management Office and you will receive your residence permit cards after some time.
- All applications will be processed together with the Erasmus+ Office. Only incoming students who are not Turkish and who follow IAU courses from Turkey need to apply for IKAMET.

IAU STUDENT CARD.

With this card you can use the student entrance and UBIS System via our Kiosks IT Department (D Block) issues these cards ! IF you lose this card at any time during your Mobility visit the Erasmus+ Office ASAP.

I.E.T.T. STUDENT TRANSPORTATION CARD

With this transportation card, you can travel anywhere you want in Istanbul at a discounted rate.

The only thing you have to do is to go to any IETT Office and give them your student letter and one photo and pay the card fee- 10 TL. After you obtain this card, you have to match it with your HES Code.










Health Insurance



BEFORE LEAVING YOUR COUNTRY:

Get 2 original signed and stamped forms from your national medical insurance company:

GERMANY: T/A 11 form

NETHERLANDS: N/TUR 111 form

BELGIUM: B.T.8 form AUSTRIA: A/TR 3 form

ALTERNATIVE: AT IAU, upon registration (J block, ground floor)

NOTE: the health insurance policies made in your home country, apart from the forms mentioned above, will not be accepted by the Foreigner's Police when applying for a Residence Permit BUT you can still use them to get treatment in Turkey www.ua.gov.tr

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
